ADVISORY: CURRENT ARRIVALS AND MANDATORY QUARANTINE PROCEDURES ON GUAM

The Philippine Consulate General in Agana (the Consulate) informs the public of the following current mandatory quarantine procedures for all arriving individuals on Guam from areas with no cases or imported/sporadic cases, per Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) Guidance Memo 2021-11 Rev11 Amendment 1:

- *“CDC GUIDELINES FOR INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL. On January 12, 2021, the CDC announced an Order requiring all air passengers arriving in the U.S. from a foreign country to get tested no more than three (3) days before their flight departs and to present the negative result or documentation of having recovered from COVID-19 to the airline before boarding the flight. Air passengers will also be required to confirm that the information they present is true in the form of an attestation.*
- *All incoming travelers who have been fully vaccinated with a U.S. Food and Drug Administration authorized COVID-19 vaccines, upon verification, are not subject to quarantine at a government facility.*
- *Arriving individuals (air or sea) who do not qualify for exemption as outlined in the DPHSS Guidance Memorandum 2021-11 Rev 11, but originated from a country with a transmission classification of “No Active Cases” or “Imported/Sporadic Cases,” as defined by the World Health Organization (WHO), are not required to have a COVID-19 test and are not required to quarantine at a Government of Guam Quarantine Facility (QFac). However, such individuals must complete their 10-day quarantine period at their personal residence or rental lodging and are subject to the following requirements:*
 1. *Must sign a new Voluntary Quarantine Acknowledgement form;*
 2. *Must provide:*
 - a. *A valid physical address;*
 - b. *A working phone number where they may be contacted; and*
 - c. *A working email address.*

3. *Must comply with symptom monitoring for 14 days after arrival via Sara Alert; and*
 4. *Individual is encouraged to download the Guam COVID Alert App. May not receive any visitors except for contactless delivery of food and supplies;*
 5. *May only leave the quarantine location for the following purposes; purchase groceries, exercise outdoors, pick-up curbside/drive-through food services, and for medical emergencies and medical appointments.”*
- *Individuals who do not meet the above criteria and tested negative for COVID-19 on day 6 at the QFac will be cleared from quarantine. However, these individuals must comply with symptom monitoring for the remainder of their 14-day quarantine period via Sara Alert; and all individuals are encouraged to download the [Guam COVID Alert App](#).*
