## ADVISORY: Revised Travel Guidelines to the Philippines per IATF-MEID Resolution No. 119 series of 2021

SRRV-Holders are no longer required to present an entry exemption document to enter the Philippines

Pursuant to Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-MEID) Resolution No. 119 dated 03 June 2021, the Philippine Consulate General in Agana informs the public of the following update on existing travel restrictions to the Philippines:

"Upon the recommendation of the Department of Tourism, foreign nationals holding **Special Resident Retiree's Visa (SRRV) shall be allowed to enter the Philippines without the need of an entry exemption document.** "

SRRV visa holders are advised to directly contact the Bureau of Immigration regarding all matters on entering the Philippines.

Please note that foreign nationals who wish to enter the Philippines under the 9(a) single-entry temporary visitor visa category shall continue to require an entry exemption document from the Department of Foreign Affairs.
