CNMI in the NEW RED LIST + TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS PER IATF RESOLUTION NO. 154-C

December 16, 2021

The Philippine Consulate General in Guam informs the public that the Commonwealth of Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI) is now included in the IATF Red List of countries/jurisdiction/territories effective **16 December 2021** up to **31 December 2021**.

Required to undergo facility-based quarantine until the release of their negative RT-PCR test taken on the 3rd day. After which, they shall be required to undergo home quarantine until their 10th day, with the date of arrival being the first day. 	 Negative RT-PCR test taken within 72 hours prior to departure from the country of origin. Upon arrival, they shall undergo facility-based quarantine with an RT-PCR test taken on the 5th day, with the date of arrival being the first day.
